PLEASE NOTE: The grounds will be available for you to set up at 12:00 noon January 30, 2015. Please keep your set-ups clean, pick up after your dogs and do not leave trash on the field trial grounds. There is a clubhouse on the grounds. Roll call and meals will be held in the clubhouse.

DIRECTIONS

From Kirbyville, TX

US Highway 96 runs north - south through Kirbyville. From US-96, turn east onto FM-82. Proceed 0.4 miles and turn to the right to cross the railroad tracks. After the tracks, turn left to stay on FM-82. Continue 1.4 miles on FM-82 and then turn right on County Road 3076. Windsong Acres (1270 CR 3076) will be on the right about 1/2 mile from FM-82.

ENTRY FEES

\$22.00 per entry for all regular class stakes. No charge for Best Open, Best FC or Absolute run. Please submit separate entries for each trial. **Make checks payable to DFWDC for entries and meals.**

Be sure to bring your dogs' entry information with you. Dogs must be present on the grounds at the time entries close to be entered officially. Owners are responsible for providing correct information on their entry forms.

Please note the divided FC classes and make proper notation on the entry form.

RUNNING ORDER

Classes will be run concurrently as listed below. Please be prepared for this running order. **The field trial committee reserves the right to make changes to the running order as needed to expedite the events.**

Saturday, January 31, 2015: OAAD & FCD, followed by OAAB & FCB
Sunday, February 1, 2015: OAAB & FCB, followed by OAAD & FCD

Best of Open, Best Field Champion and Absolute will follow immediately at the conclusion of the running of the last stake of the day.

DRESS

It is recommended that sturdy shoes or boots and durable clothing be worn. Bring appropriate gear, as the trial will be run rain or shine.

PRACTICE WILL BE PERMITTED ONLY ON FRIDAY, JANUARY 30th after 2:00 pm. Fee is \$4.00 / dog, payable to Dean Biscamp. Each handler will be allowed to take only one dog at a time into the rabbit enclosure. No practice after dark. A \$40 fee will be charged for any rabbit killed or injured by a dog or person. **The trial committee reserves the right to cancel the practice session.**
