DIRECTIONS FROM I-30

Coming from the west through Greenville

Take Exit 96 towards TX-302. Turn left onto TX-302 Spur W / Lee Street. In 2 miles, turn right onto Johnson Street. At fork in road, veer right onto Commerce Drive. In 0.5 miles, turn left onto TX-34 N / Wolfe City Drive. Continue north on TX-34 for approximately 15 miles to Wolfe City. In Wolfe City, TX-34 turns left (from Crockett Street onto Santa Fe Street). Continue with the directions from Wolfe City.

Coming from the east through Sulphur Springs

Continue on I-30 west of Sulphur Springs and take Exit 116. Turn right onto FM 2635 N. In 5 miles, turn left onto TX-11 W. Follow TX-11 for 8 miles to city of Commerce. Turn right onto TX-11 Business (Maple Street). In 1 mile, turn right onto Park Street to remain on TX-11. In 0.9 miles, turn left onto Neal Street to remain on TX-11. Continue on TX-11 for 13 miles. In Wolfe City, turn right onto TX-34 N.

From Wolfe City to LSDC

After leaving Wolfe City, continue north on TX-34 for approximately 5 miles. Turn left on CR 3355 (white gravel road). Follow CR 3355 for approximately 1 mile. The entrance to LSDC will be on your left.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

GROUNDS

The grounds will available for set up at 12:00 noon on Thursday, December 7, 2017. Please park on the gravel lot. No vehicles on the grass areas except as authorized by LSDC. Crating and EZ ups are not allowed on the parking surface. Please keep your set-ups clean, pick up after your dogs and do not leave trash (including baggies, water bottles, etc.) in the field trial grounds. The event committee and the landowners ask that exhibitors remove their trash from the grounds each night. Do not place trash in the outhouse holding tanks. All dogs must be on lead or secure in x-pens / crates except when under judgment during the trial. It is strongly advised that no dogs be left unattended in ex-pens.

PRACTICE

There will be no practice on the grounds prior to or after these trials.

DRESS

It is recommended that sturdy shoes or boots and durable clothing be worn. Bring appropriate gear, as the trial will be run rain or shine.

FOOD

Meals for the Field Trials will be provided by LSDC, LLC. LSDC will be offering LUNCH ONLY for \$7.00 per person. Please make checks for food payable to LSDC, LLC. Food will be provided by Reservation ONLY. We welcome and greatly appreciate desserts from any exhibitor wishing to participate.
