DIRECTIONS FROM I-30

Coming from the west through Greenville

Take Exit 96 towards TX-302 spur. Turn left onto TX-302 Spur W / Lee Street. In 2 miles, turn right onto Johnson Street. At fork in road, veer right onto Commerce Drive. In 0.5 miles, turn left onto TX-34 N / Wolfe City Drive.

Continue north on TX-34 for approximately 15 miles to Wolfe City. In Wolfe City, TX-34 turns left (from Crockett Street onto Santa Fe Street).

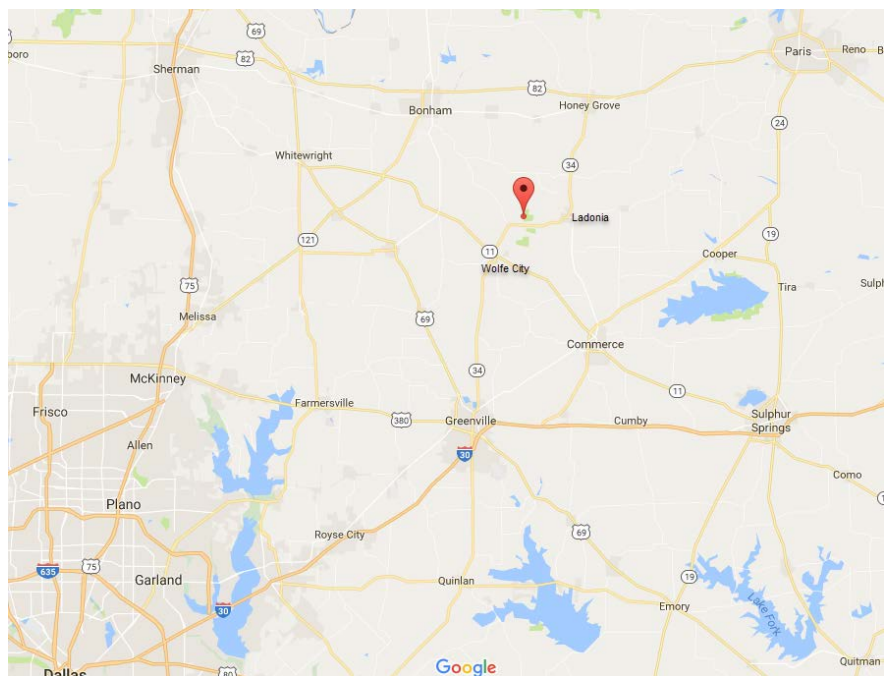
Continue with the directions from Wolfe City.

Coming from the east through Sulphur Springs

Continue on I-30 west of Sulphur Springs and take Exit 116. Turn right onto FM 2653 N. In 5 miles, turn left onto TX-11 W. Follow TX-11 for 8 miles to city of Commerce. Turn right onto TX-11 Business (Maple Street). In 1 mile, turn right onto Park Street to remain on TX-11. In 0.9 miles, turn left onto Neal Street to remain on TX-11. Continue on TX-11 for 13 miles. In Wolfe City, turn right onto TX-34 N.

From Wolfe City to LSCD

After leaving Wolfe City, continue north on TX-34 for approximately 5 miles. Turn left on CR 3355 (white gravel road). There are 3 signs located on TX-34 at this turn. On the left side of the road, there is a brown historical marker and a green Rehoboth Cemetery sign. On the right side, there is a green Ladonia city limit sign. Follow CR 3355 for approximately 1 mile. The entrance to LSCD will be on your left.



ENTRY FEES

\$25.00 per entry for all regular class stakes. No charge for Best Open, Best FC or Absolute run. Please submit separate entries for each trial. **Make checks payable to DFWDCA for entries.** Be sure to bring your dogs' entry information with you. Dogs must be present on the grounds at the time entries close to be entered officially. Owners are responsible for providing correct information on their entry forms.

RUNNING ORDER AND ABSOLUTE PROCEDURE

DCA Standing Rule regarding Absolute (approved by DCA Board on October 14, 2017):

"Absolute is a competition held for the winners of all regular classes at an AKC licensed or member Dachshund field trial. It may be awarded at any field trial that offers both Open All Age and Field Champion stakes.

The running procedure for Absolute shall be at the discretion of the field trial committee and shall be specified in the premium list. Bitches that are in season, as determined by the field trial committee, are ineligible for Absolute if there are any male class winners competing. Absolute may be withheld for lack of merit but not for lack of competition.

The AKC criteria for eligibility to judge is defined in "Field Trial Rules and Standard Procedure for Dachshunds", Chapter 5, and shall be applied to the selection of judges for Absolute. The judges for Absolute may either be advertised in the premium list or selected the day of the trial by the field trial committee."

Stakes will be run concurrently with OAAD & FCD first, followed by OAAB & FCB as the field(s) become available.

At the field trial committee's discretion, the Best of Open competition may be held any time after the completion of the OAAB and OAAD stakes. Similarly, the Best FC competition may be held any time after the completion of the FCB and FCD stakes. The Absolute run will be held once the Best of Open and Best FC winners have been identified.

Judges for all post-stake competitions will be selected by the field trial committee at the trial with the following caveats:

- (1) Two judges will preside over each of the post-stake competitions.
- (2) The same pair does not have to officiate over all post-stake competitions.

Please be prepared for this running order. The field trial committee reserves the right to make changes to the running order as needed to expedite the events.

GROUND

The grounds will be available for you to set up at 12:00 noon on February 2, 2018. All set-ups must be removed within 2 hours of the completion of the trial on Sunday, February 4th. Parking is permitted only in the paved lot. No vehicles are allowed on the grassy areas at any time unless authorized by LSDC. Crating and EZ ups are not allowed on the parking surface.

Please keep your set-ups clean, pick up after your dogs and do not leave trash (including baggies) at the field trial grounds. The event committee and the landowners ask that exhibitors remove their trash from the grounds each night.

All dogs must be on lead or in secure ex-pens / crates at all times except when under instruction of the judges during the running of the stakes. **It is strongly advised that no dogs be left unattended in ex-pens.**

There will be NO PRACTICE permitted on the grounds prior to or after these trials.

DRESS

It is recommended that sturdy shoes or boots and durable clothing be worn. Bring appropriate gear, as the trial will be run rain or shine.

MEALS

Meals (LUNCH) will be provided by RESERVATION ONLY. Make food checks payable to LSDC, LLC.

Lunch is \$7.00. If you are planning on eating any meals served at these trials, you MUST make reservations by contacting Cathy Gunn at cathy@gunndox.com by January 26th.
