EXHIBITORS, PLEASE READ

*Prospering Farms is a working Hunter Jumper Equestrian Training Facility. As such there will be normal activity involving horses, riders and grooms in and around the barns and arenas. **For the safety of all the speed is 10 mph while on the property. 10 mph is the limit, not a suggestion!**

***Exhibitors** are also responsible for their children. Unaccompanied children are not allowed in or near the barns, arenas, turnouts or pastures anywhere on the property.

***Exhibitors and their dogs are not allowed on any agility equipment on the property.**

***The test is being held at the back of the property away from the barns, turnouts and arenas. Follow the signs to the Earthdog Test location.**

***There is no club house on the property. A port-a-potty will be provided.**

***There is plenty of room for parking and EZ-Ups. Please park only in the designated area.**

***Lunch will NOT be served either day. Bring your snacks, treats and water for your dogs. There are several fast food restaurants in the area close to the test site on Preston Road north of East First St. or on Highway 380 east of La Cima Blvd.**

* **PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOGS! Only COMPLETE entry forms including REGISTRATION/ILP/PAL numbers will be accepted. Please complete a **SEPARATE ENTRY FORM** for EACH DOG and each CLASS entered. Make sure all information is correct and entry form has been signed.**

EARTHDOG TRIAL REGULATIONS

***THE FOLLOWING BREEDS ARE CLASSIFIED AS ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE**

AKC EARTHDOG TESTS: DACHSHUNDS and the following TERRIER BREEDS:

Australian, Belington, Border, Cairn, Cesky, Dandie Dinmont, Fox (Smooth and Wire), Glen of Imaal, Jagdterrier, Lakeland, Manchester, Miniature Bull, Miniature Pinchers, Miniature Schnauzers, Norfolk, Norwich, Parson Russell, Rat, Russell, Scottish, Sealyham, Silky, Skye, Welsh, West Highland White, & Yorkshire.

ELIGIBILITY: Dogs must be at least 6 months old. Dogs that are spayed or neutered or have a Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative (ILP or PAL) number may participate. A dog of an eligible breed with an acceptable with an acceptable foreign registration is eligible to participate.

MULTIPLE ENTRIES: Dogs may enter more than one regular class at an earthdog test provided the dog is eligible for the class as defined in AKC regulations for Earthdog Tests, Chapter 3. **Note: Entries for each test should be on a separate entry form.**

NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

1. **BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO RUN.** Bitches in season shall not be allowed to enter within 100 feet of any test area during the running of any class. Entry fees will be returned for bitches that come into season if the show secretary is notified no later than ½ hour before entries close for the first class of the day and notification is accompanied by a vet's certificate.
2. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian or barred by the Test Committee. No entry fees will be returned if the test cannot start or be completed due to an ACT OF GOD or beyond control of the test committee.
3. The test committee may decline any entries or remove any dog from the event for cause, but in each such instance shall file good and sufficient reasons for doing so with the American Kennel Club.
4. The owner or handler entering a dog in these TESTS does so at his/her own risk and agrees to assume responsibility for any damage caused by him/her or by his/her dog. Anyone attending also agrees to abide by all rules on the premium list.
5. Barking dogs outside the TEST AREA should be removed from the area but not disciplined for barking.
6. **FLEX LEADS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED AT THE TEST SITE.**
7. All dogs are to be on leash or confined to exercise pens while on test grounds. Please be considerate of others when setting up ex-pens. Space should be condensed as much as possible.
8. No dog will be allowed in the TEST AREA until his or her judging time.
9. Confirmed entrants not present at the TESTING AREA when their number is called will be moved to the bottom of the class. Master Earthdog entrants will be declared absent if they DO NOT show up within 5 minutes of their brace being called.
10. Exhibition Only Entries for non-eligible breeds will NOT be accepted.
See show regulations for eligibility requirements.
11. Wear weather appropriate gear.

CLASSES OFFERED IN ALL THREE TESTS OFFERED:

- **Introduction to Quarry (Intro)** – Non-regular class. Open to all dogs 6 months or older. DEN is 10 feet with one 90 degree turn.
- **Junior Earthdog** – Open to all AKC eligible breeds of dogs. Junior Earthdog titled dogs may continue to enter but may not receive another certificate. DEN is 30 feet with three 90 degree turns.
- **Senior Earthdog** – Open to dogs that have acquired the Junior Earthdog title and to dogs that have been recorded by the AKC as Senior or Master Earthdog. DEN is 30 feet with three 90 degree turns with false den & false exit. Dogs must be recalled out of the den.
- **Master Earthdog** – Dogs that have earned a Senior or Master ED title. DEN is 30 feet with three 90 degree turns with false den & false exit. Dogs are braced with another dog in an approximately 100 yards hunt up and must accurately indicate entrance and honor another working dog.

SHOW REGULATIONS

***THE FOLLOWING BREEDS ARE CLASSIFIED AS ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE AKC EARTHDOG TESTS:** DACHSHUNDS and the following TERRIER BREEDS: Australian, Belington, Border, Cairn, Cesky, Dandie Dinmont, Fox (Smooth and Wire), Glen of Imaal, Jagdferrier, Lakeland, Manchester, Miniature Bull, Miniature Pinchers, Miniature Schnauzers, Norfolk, Norwich, Parson Russell, Rat, Russell, Scottish, Sealyham, Silky, Skye, Welsh, West Highland White, & Yorkshire.

ELIGIBILITY: Dogs must be at least 6 months old. Dogs that are spayed or neutered or have a Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative (ILP or PAL) number may participate. A dog of an eligible breed with an acceptable foreign registration is eligible to participate.

MULTIPLE ENTRIES: Dogs may enter more than one regular class at an Earthdog test provided the dog is eligible for the class as defined in AKC regulations for Earthdog Tests, Chapter 3.

THE ENDURANCE EARTH DOG TITLE

In order to be eligible to earn an Endurance Earthdog (EE) title, a dog must have already earned a Master Earthdog title. An Endurance Earthdog title is earned when a dog on five occasions passes both the Senior and Master classes at the same event (one event number). The owner shall record each of the five Double Qualification on a form provided by AKC. Once five Double Qualifications have been awarded the completed form is then submitted to AKC along with a title recording fee of \$30.00. Upon verification, a title will be issued to the owner and the dog shall be identified as an Endurance Earthdog by the suffix title EE.
