From I-30 in Greenville, TX to Wolfe City

Exit Hwy 34 North (Exit #93). Follow Hwy 34 (aka Wesley St.) thru Greenville (4 miles) Continue to follow the signs through town. Hwy 34 makes a right turn (aka O'Neal St.) near AutoZone & Dollar General. Go 2 blocks and turn left (aka Johnson St.). Cross bridge and continue on Hwy 34 past downtown. At fork in road, veer right for Hwy 34 (Wolfe City/Commerce). After fork, take a left at Gas Station (still Hwy 34). Continue north on Hwy 34 for approx. 14.6 miles to Wolfe City. From the University Inn, turn right out of the parking lot onto Hwy 50 heading into Commerce. Take the exit ramp for Hwy 11 headed Northwest (turn left). Follow highway 11 to Wolfe City. Turn right on Hwy 34 and continue with the directions From Wolfe City.

From Wolfe City to LSDC

After leaving Wolfe City, continue on Hwy 34 for approximately 4-5miles Turn left on CR 3355 (white gravel road).

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

- 1. NO bitches in season will be allowed to run. Entry Fees paid for a bitch that comes into season will be refunded with notification before entries close. Bitches in season shall not be allowed to enter the test and shall not be allowed within 100 feet of a testing area during the running of any class.**
- 2. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified or excused by the Judge or the Veterinarian, or barred by the Test Committee. No entry fees will be returned if the test cannot start or be completed due to an ACT OF God or any cause beyond control of the Test Committee.**
- 3. The Test Committee may decline any entries or may remove any dog from the event for cause, but in each such instance shall file good and sufficient reasons for doing so with the American Kennel Club.**
- 4. The owner or handler entering a dog in these TESTS does so at his/her own risk and agrees to assume responsibility for any damage caused by him/her or by his/her dog. He/she also agrees to abide by all rules set forth in the Premium List.**
- 5. Barking dogs outside of the TEST AREA should be removed from the area but not disciplined for barking.**
- 6. FLEX LEADS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED AT THE TEST SITE.**
- 7. No dog will be allowed in the TEST AREA until his or her judging time.**
- 8. Confirmed entrants not present at the TESTING AREA when their number is called will be moved to the bottom of the class. Master Earthdog entrants will be declared absent if they do not show within 5 minutes of their brace being called.**
- 9. No EXHIBITION ONLY ENTRIES for non-eligible dogs will be accepted. See show regulations for eligibility requirements.**

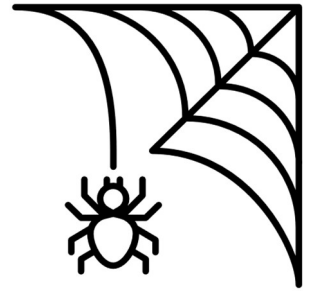
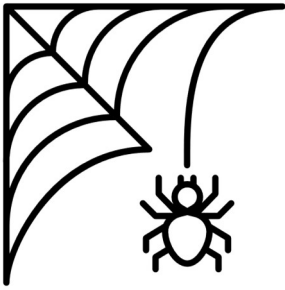
